

New single: *Pilgrim* by Ingrid Jasmin

Ingrid Jasmin is a new voice on the Norwegian music scene. In 2021, she has performed at venues such as Førdefestivalen and Telemarkfestivalen, Riksscenen and Cosmopolite Scene. On November 12, she will release *Pilgrim*, her first single.

- The song opens with a folk tune that I have sung since I was little. To me *Pilgrim* is about feeling that one belongs everywhere and at the same time nowhere, says Ingrid Jasmin.

On November 12, the music video for the song, produced by Elisa Bates, will also be released.

- I wanted the music and the video to bring out the feeling that life carries you away. You hold on and do the best you can.

Collaboration across genres

Bassist Mattis Kleppen and harding fiddle player Tuva Færden join her on the song.

- Tuva has an incredible feeling for what she does, and there is no one in the world who plays bass like Mattis. I think you can hear that in the recording, says Ingrid Jasmin.

In preparing the single, she has also worked with flamenco instrumentalist Yannick Corre. *Pilgrim* mixes traditional motifs and acoustic instruments with electronic production.

- We have consciously held back in the production of the song. It was about stripping it down to the core so that the organic elements would stand out.

Pilgrim was recorded in SAGA Studio, and is produced by Jonas Kroon, Ingrid Jasmin, Bernt Isak Wærstad and Almir Meskovic. The single is mixed by Jonas Kroon and mastered by George Tanderø.
